For the first time, the PPE Center for Social and Institutional Change - **CSIC** (formerly Witten Institute of Institutional Change, WIWA) announces the "PPE Best Paper Award". Among the submitted papers, the best research will be endowed with **500 euros** by the Board of Trustees of Witten/Herdecke University. The decision for the winning paper is based on a review process involving members of both the conference team and the CSIC.

The award ceremony will take place as part of the PPE conference on **Saturday 18th April 2020**.
